## Technical Information

### Applications

Accent II is an ideal choice for a permanent turf in cool climates due to its remarkable wear tolerance, seedling vigor, high density during spring and summer, and exceptional winter hardiness. In warmer climates, winter overseeding can be beneficial as it provides seedling vigor and good quality turf that can be mowed at a height of 1/2". Accent II offers advantages that can meet the specific needs of sports turf, depending on the climate and the intended use. At Michigan State University under simulated traffic, Accent II demonstrated superior wear tolerance and maintained high percent living ground cover. Accent II performs well in the transition zone, but has also demonstrated superior cold tolerance and adaptation in more northern climates. In university trials at North Dakota and Wisconsin with serious winter kill, Accent II ranked among the top 10, clearly demonstrating its superior winter survival and adaptation.

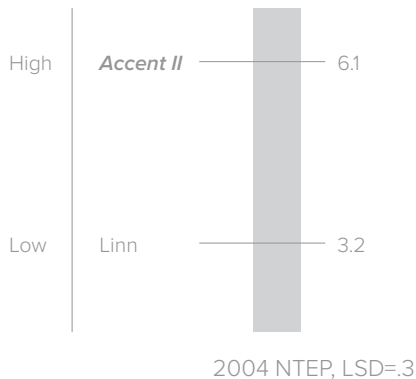

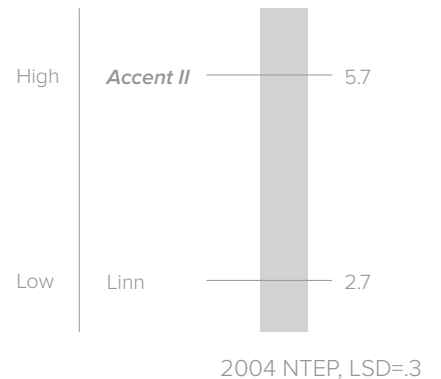
Seeding Rate: 5-10lbs./M\*

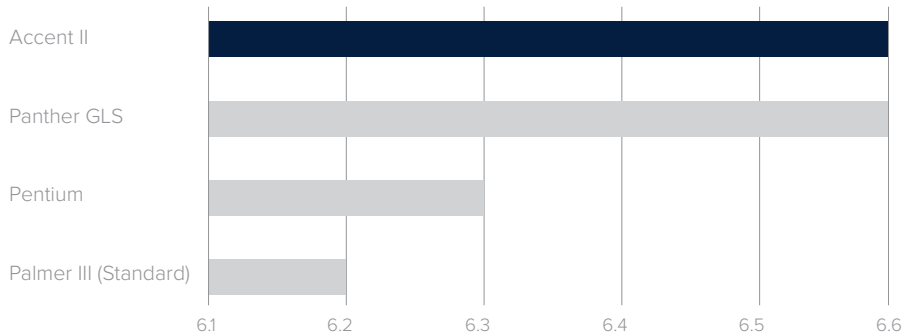
