Audubon ranked #1 in spring greenup in national trials, and was among the best for fall color retention in September, October, and November. Audubon has very good resistance to Brown Patch, Melting Out, and Summer Patch Disease and moderate resistance to Pythium Blight, Red Thread, Leaf Spot, and Dollar Spot. Audubon is very drought tolerant -- in national trials it was #1 against wilting and #2 against dormancy.

Technical Information

Applications

Strong Creeping Red fescue's sod forming, rhizomatous nature makes it suitable for sod production, while also giving it the ability to recover from damage or divots. Audubon is recommended for home lawns, parks, corporate landscapes and golf course roughs or out-of-play areas. Adapted to sandy, infertile, and droughty soils, Audubon is an excellent choice on areas where regular maintenance is not possible, such as embankments, deep roughs, and roadsides. Under unmown conditions, Audubon will put up seedheads during the summer adding to the contours of your landscape. Audubon is a good choice when used alone or matched with other Jacklin grasses in mixtures and blends for permanent turf in temperate and transition zone climates. It is often a component of Jacklin Seed's Scottish Links blend.
