Bermudagrass produces a vigorous, deeprooted and medium green, dense turf which is well adapted to most soils and grows the best in warm climates. Bermudagrass spreads by both rhizomes and stolons. It has excellent wear, drought, heat and salt tolerance, establishes quickly, produces lateral stems and is competitive against weeds.

Technical Information

Applications

Uniform leaf texture and its ability to establish very quickly, makes it an ideal choice for a number of applications including home lawns, sports fields and reclamation requirements. Bargusto is an improved seeded variety of Bermudagrass. 'Improved' Bermudagrass types are mostly seeded varieties and are darker green, deeper rooted, medium textured and denser compared to common Bermudagrass.

Establishment

Seeding and establishment may be done in spring or fall, but be weary of summer or winter annuals. Plant seeds to a depth of no more than 0.25-0.50" below the soil surface to ensure good seed to soil contact. Thatch layers will only slow or impede germination success. After spreading seed, keep seedbed moist throughout germination, with extra care during the early stages to prevent seed from drying out after initial seed imbibition.
