Barpearl slender creeping red fescue specializes in areas under low mowing heights thanks to its extremely fine leaves and high shoot density. It will often comprise some or major portions of mixtures when used on links-style, sand-based golf course playing surfaces (putting greens, tees, and fairways). Barpearl possesses salt tolerance, Red Thread and Fusarium resistance, and strong shade tolerance known to the species. It blends well with other fine leaf fescues or can be seeded on its own.

Compared to its counterpart, Strong Creeping Red Fescue, Slender creepers are not as dark in color, nor are they as aggressive through their weaker rhizome production. In return, Slender fescue provides advantages in density and tolerance to close mowing and salt tolerance.
