This Chewings fescue variety has a medium-dark color and can form a very fine, dense turf stand capable of tolerating shade, cold winters, and low maintenance conditions such as low fertility, infrequent mowing, and reduced irrigation in cooler climates.

Applications

Bridgeport II is a versatile fine fescue able to grow in low nutrient soils from coastal to northern areas of the United States and Canada. Low input requirements often lead to applications on golf courses and home lawns either in fine fescue blends or as multi-species mixtures.

Maintenance

Seeding Rate:	4-6lbs./M*
Maintained at Turf Heights: Unmown Areas:	0.5-1lbs./M (thin)
Overseeding into Existing Turf:	3-5lbs./M (dense)
Mowing (Recommendation):	6-10lbs./M 1.5-3.0"
Mowing (Down To):	0.200"
