Technical Information

Applications

Chilly Verde is excellent on golf courses, sports fields, parks and home lawns. Its ability to adapt to a wide range of soil types allows it to be used in some of the harshest southern soils while its improved cold tolerance pushes it further north in the transition zone. Chilly Verde's quick establishment and excellent turf quality not only exceeds in performance, but aesthetically as well.

Establishment

Seeding and establishment may be done in spring or fall, but be wary of summer or winter annuals. Plant seeds to a depth of no more than 0.25-0.50" below the soil surface to ensure good seed to soil contact. Thatch layers will only slow or impede germination success. After spreading seed, keep seedbed moist throughout germination, with extra care during the early stages to prevent seed from drying out after initial seed imbibition.
