The combination of 85% Kentucky bluegrass and 15% perennial ryegrass makes for the ideal turf, with an optimum ratio of bluegrass and perennial ryegrass tillers in the maturing turf. The perennial ryegrass in Heisman will provide fast germination and excellent soil stabilization while establishing a dominant Kentucky bluegrass stand.

Technical Information

Applications

Heisman Turf Mix is designed for use in any high-performance landscape area, such as a golf course fairway or primary rough, athletic field, or lawn. The elite-type bluegrasses in the blend will tolerate low-mowing heights down to .5".

Specifications

Seeding and establishment may be done in spring or fall, but be wary of summer or winter annuals. For better early weed control, consider an application of Mesotrione in the seeding process. Plant seeds to a depth of no more than 0.25-0.50" below the soil surface to ensure good seed to soil contact. Thatch layers will only slow or impede germination success. After spreading seed, keep seedbed moist throughout germination, with extra care during the early stages to prevent seed from drying out after initial seed imbibition. Germination should begin within 5 to 7 days and be complete within 35 days. Remember, the full turfgrass establishment process may take 6 months to a year.
