
#### **Specifications**

Keep seedbed moist to enhance germination. Germination should begin within 7 to 14 days and be complete within 21 days. The stand should establish in 30 days. Remember, the full turfgrass establishment process may take 6 months to a year. Mow at 1 to 4 inches, depending on use. Ideally maintain at 2 12 to 3 inch mowing height. Do not remove more than 1/3 of total plant height with each mowing. After establishment, a deep watering program is recommended to improve root depth. Irrigate according to turfgrass needs for your geographical area.
