Navy is an early-maturing Kentucky bluegrass with fast establishment and good tolerance to powdery mildew. Navy jumps out of the ground earlier in the spring to give your sod or landscape mix an edge on spring green-up. Navy has an attractive, medium-dark color, medium-compact growth habit, and blends well with either darker or lighter varieties.

Technical Information

Applications

Navy is a bluegrass that offers excellent versatility for use in applications from medium to high maintenance. Use Navy alone or in blends for medium-maintenance lawns, parks, or athletic fields, or elevate it to high maintenance applications in blends with more elite varieties. Navy is a good choice for areas with early spring use and for competing with spring weeds.

Specifications

Seeding and establishment may be done in spring or fall, but be wary of summer or winter annuals. For better early weed control, consider an application of Mesotrione in the seeding process. Plant seeds to a depth of no more than 0.25-0.50" below the soil surface to ensure good seed to soil contact. Thatch layers will only slow or impede germination success. After spreading seed, keep seedbed moist throughout germination, with extra care during the early stages to prevent seed from drying out after initial seed imbibition. Germination should begin within 10 to 21 days and be complete within 35 days. Remember, the full turfgrass establishment process may take 6 months to a year.
