This is a low input variety regarding nutrient use, drought tolerance, and salt tolerance. Ideal for use in moderate to temperate climates, Sprinkler can help reduce the impact on the environment as well as maintenance budget.

Compared to its counterpart, Strong Creeping Red fescue, Slender Creepers are not as dark in color, nor are they as aggressive through their weaker rhizome production. In return, Slender fescue provides advantages in density and tolerance to close mowing and salt tolerance.
