Maintenance

Seeding rate: 5-10lbs./M*
Overseeding dormant bermudagrass on greens: 10-30lbs./M
On fairways: 200-500lbs/acre
Mowing (recommendation): 0.5"-2"
Mowing (down to): 0.44"
*M=1,000 square feet

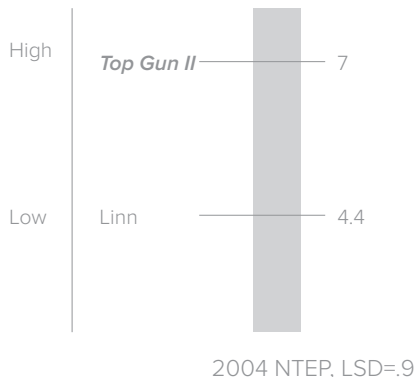

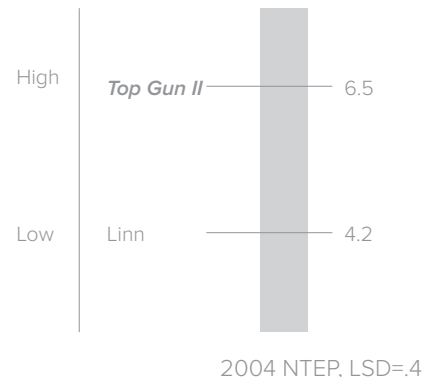
Applications

Top Gun II is adapted for use on golf course fairways, roughs, and tees; sports fields, home lawns, parks, schools, and industrial sites in cooler regions. Top Gun II is also recommended for winter overseeding on dormant bermudagrass in warmer regions. In more southern areas, Top Gun II has shown its adaptability to overseeding. In an overseeding trial on dormant bermudagrass at Toscana Country Club in Indian Wells, CA, Top Gun II displayed great quality, color and density and can be mown down to very low heights (0.44 in., or 11 mm). When trialed under simulated traffic conditions at Michigan State University, Top Gun II was among the top 10 out of 120 entries.

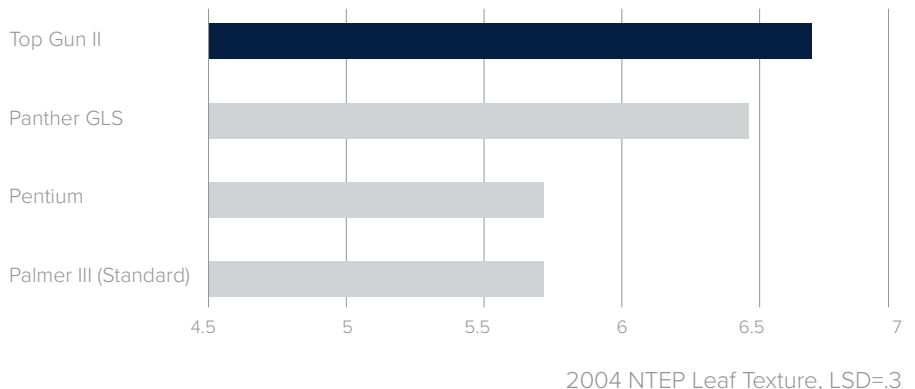
Density
